In the world of Corvairs there is always 1 more thing to do. So keep dreaming and keep planning and keep working.



Bob's Tech Corner

As you all know I'm am always busy with something in the shop. This month I decided to tackle some CORSA horn buttons that were missing one of their spring retainers!

This should also apply to the LM Monza as well.

Although we can purchase a repair kit from Corvair vendors, I didn't want to spend the extra monies nor shipping charges, when I could source a few screws

locally and use the drill bits already at my disposal.

Going to my local hardware store, I purchased 9 stainless steel #8 Screws, 1 in long. The nuts I had and used for measuring the length I need for the repair.

After Measuring the length I needed \, I cut the screws with #9 cutters then relieved the cut threads. I then removed the nuts to straighten any threads that

might have been damaged in order to be able to screw into the soft diecast horn button (after I drilled it to the proper size. NO I did not tap the drilled hole.











Once the threads are started by an un cut screw, I put blue thread locker on the cut screw and screw it down tight



The 4 tabs holding the plastic emblem might be loose, letting the plastic insert rattle. They are easily tapped to tighten the insert but don't push or tap

them with a hammer too hard as they can break and possibly ruin your horn button insert. The 9, #8 screws I bought at a hardware store, cost less than \$3.00. Vendors get over \$5.00 for 4 screws.

Although I used #8 screws, # 6 will work when using the appropriate drill bit. The screw heads will not interfere with the operation of the horn button!



Good luck with your next project. If anyone has a horn question please don't hesitate in contacting me with them. I am always happy to help! See you at the cook out..... Bob Welch If anyone wants a certain tech topic covered please let me know








