

Bob's Tech Corner

Buckle up, get your favorite drink and sit back and read (hopefully) some enlightening information about those parts out there, in the on line world and in the garages and attics of your fellow Corvair lovers. In researching the topic of available parts (for our Corvairs in particular), there are many parts available. Compared to the more popular "Classics" to restore however, the sources/ vendors ARE limited! Therefore, we as Corvair enthusiasts, must know the difference in the terms of NOS, OEM and NORS! So, Just what do these terms mean?

NOS = NEW OLD STOCK.

It means that the dealer ordered these parts from GM for repair of a certain vehicle, but they were never used. So these parts are inventory or "Stock" that is "Old" but still "New".

These type parts sat on shelves in dealerships all over the country waiting for you to find them. It doesn't matter who got them off the dealer shelves, (American Corvair, Corvair 1 Clark's, You get the idea) they are still new parts for your car. The NOS parts seem to be the most desirable, because they were made for a particular car and will fit without issue and perform as intended.

OEM = Original Equipment Manufacture

I have found that some folks restoring their projects, regard OEM as the next best thing to NOS. Usually these parts have been licensed to be manufactured by a third party supplier, where the NORS parts have not been LICENSED by the original manufacturer! As we have all seen with parts in the engine compartment, GM used many suppliers through the years and the fitment is not always spot on. There are many examples out there. Let me know the fitment issues that you have experienced with OEM parts and I will share them in our news letter. Also note that when you find a nice but used part that has been cleaned and painted, that does not make it an OEM part! It is still a used part, Clean though it may be!

NORS.= New Old Replacement Stock

These are the parts that fit your Corvair but are from a third party supplier. The best way to explain it... For example, Chevrolet and GM produced 1 oil filter for the Corvair, the AC Delco PH4, regardless of the year. However, many many oil filter brands popped up during the 10 year run of the Corvair! James Erginbright has collected over 60 different oil filter brands, each having its own unique part number. Another example is all the electronic ignitions that are showing up for and in Corvairs. Or you can use the following as a rule of thumb... If it is not AC Delco, and it is new in another manufacturer's packaging, it is NORS. OR... think of NORS as "period correct" replacement parts in THEIR manufacturer's packaging NOT having GM's AC Delco label.

Our club, Central Oklahoma Corvair Association, will be hosting a Corvair (only) Swap Meet in the coming months. Many of us want to get our "extra" parts in the hands of other Corvair enthusiast, to help them and ourselves to continue our Corvair restorations and keep Corvairs on the road.!

My hope is that this little piece, will help you, the Corvair owner in your search for the correct parts for your project.

While searching for that perfect part for your Classic Corvair (of any year), You have to decide and be careful to make sure that the part you purchase will fit and perform correctly!

A few years ago Many of us in the Corvair world were discussing how many of the GM models of the same years, crossed lines within the GM House and fit not only our Corvairs but several other vehicles across other GM platforms. LM outside mirrors are a good example. They are now manufactured by a third party with GM's blessing as a "restoration" part. These mirrors usually come in a box listing all the other GM vehicles that they fit. Thus the Need to check cross platform fitment! (Many of our vendors sell these GM Restoration parts) SO, Finding these parts at a Swap meet or at a garage sale, you need to be aware or the type of part you are potentially purchasing. Do your research to be sure that you get what you pay for! Happy Hunting


