COCA Minutes August 24, 2024

President Jim Gailey opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on August 24, 2024. The meeting was held at C.E. Page Building at Wiley Post Airport. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. President Gailey welcomed the members in attendance. There were no visitors in attendance.

President Gailey asked if there was any Old Business that needed attention. There was none. Pat Silver mentioned that the following Monday, August 26, is Ann Ergenbright's birthday.

Treasurer's Report - Ken Drye presented the Treasurer's report. Ken mentioned that this was the first report that he could remember when there were no expenses or income to report. Scott Law made a motion to accept the report as presented, with a second by Ann Ergenbright. The motion was approved.

Minutes – The June 2024 meeting minutes were reviewed. Scott Law made a motion to approve the minutes, with a second by Pat Silver. The motion was approved.

President Gailey updated the group on Kate and Brandon and Kate's new work situation which was causing them to be unable to attend meetings. Jim went on to thank all those members who had brought vehicles to participate in the Bethany parade. He had received a letter from the City of Bethany thanking COCA for attending and supporting the parade. Additionally, Jim thanked those who showed up for the Hefner Mansions show. It was confirmed by several in attendance that it was a good show and the food was very good.

New Business – The Wichita Roundup is quickly approaching and President Gailey suggested making room reservations soon. He had registration forms available to any who were considering entering a car in the event and several members indicated interest in attending.

The North Texas Corvair Club is combining HOT with a benefit car show on September 14th at the Sam Pack's Museum. It is an open show and Jim has information for anyone who is interested.

James Ergenbright spoke about the Swap Meet which has been set for October 26. The COCA regular monthly meeting will be that morning as well. Set-up will begin at 8:00 in the parking lot. James has forms for vendors to fill out and send in to determine space sizing. Based upon feedback he has received, there may be a large variety of parts available. Volunteers will be needed to help cook and serve food such as hot dogs, chips, drinks, etc. Scott Law suggested using the indoor space to put out various entertainment sites such as valve cover race track, puzzles, ring toss, etc. along with tables for food. Alicia suggested putting out signage to direct parking during the event to maximize the parking area directly outside the building for vendors.

President Gailey informed the group that David Clamp has officially resigned as Vice President of the club. He then mentioned that David Allin had run for President so Jim had spoken to him and the Board about him taking the Vice President position. David had indicated that he would be willing to serve as Vice President. After discussion, David Castiaux nominated David Allin for Vice President with a second from Scott Law. The nomination was accepted and approved by the unanimous vote of the membership.

President Gailey mentioned that he had been trying to set up a backup for those instances where Scott and Donna Law were unable to attend a meeting as they were very involved with other commitments and occasionally could not attend, but had not been entirely successful in doing so yet. He asked the group for any volunteers and Joe Nels very graciously said that he would fill in any gaps when needed for Donna Law as Secretary.

Jim mentioned that he was going to be out of town here and there but really wanted to set up a road trip for the group. Ken Drye had come up with a spreadsheet of suggested destinations that had some really interesting and easy to reach places that he gave to Jim for reference. Ann Ergenbright suggested having the fall cookout in November at their house.

Delia Silver, Debbie Nels and Janet Welch gave a report on the Ladies' trip that occurred on Friday, August 23 and stated that all who attended had a great time.

David Castiaux announced that new COCA member Dwight Brown had purchased a brand new refrigerator, donated it to COCA, and had it delivered out to Ken Drye's garage for use during Cars and Cows. It is now a COCA asset. David also reminded the group that the Capron/Decker Award nominations and voting is coming up in October/November for presentation at the December/Christmas meeting.

Pat Silver mentioned that the next COCA meeting date falls on the same Saturday as the Wichita Roundup. After discussion, it was decided that the September COCA meeting would be moved to Saturday, September 21, 2024.

Richard Law spoke about attending the Corvair Nationals in Dayton, Ohio on July 22 thru 26 and how much fun he had driving in the Auto Cross with a little help from a friend. He placed Second in the event. Congratulations, Richard!

James Ergenbright brought up the subject of COCA potentially hosting the 2027 Corvair National event in Oklahoma City. The subject was discussed by many in the group with great questions asked, some with answers, some without. Potential site of the Hard Rock in Tulsa was suggested, although that venue was fairly far from everyone in Oklahoma City. Coleen Law suggested putting a small exploratory committee together to get answers to some of the questions asked, including up-front funding for venues and vendors and to ask other area clubs if they would be willing to assist. Liz Capron added several relevant suggestions as well as this would be a huge undertaking. Coleen texted a CORSA officer with some of those financial questions with answers to come. The idea of hosting the Nationals was not turned down completely, but the membership needs to get some hard questions answered before anyone will be really ready to give a thumbs-up to this type of major event.

President Gailey mentioned that Haggerty had a very nice article about Corvairs in their publication and that he would really like to get some photos at Ken's and Pat's garages to send to Haggerty and CORSA to highlight just how active a club COCA is.

There being no further discussion, Liz Capron made a motion to adjourn the meeting, with a second by Scott Law. The motion carried unanimously.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
